2016 Dr. Mary Craig: What I believe I have received from the Holy Spirit

Home [Note: Psalm 79:1-3 correlates to Revelation 11:8-10. I received this for 2016 a few hours before starting to work on the Apocalypse Bible Study on Revelation 11:7-12. What I heard is in italics.]

Psalm 79.

Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom. Luke 12:32

The LORD is your keeper. The LORD is your shade on your right hand. Psalm 121:5

The God of Israel never slumbers nor sleeps.

Psalm 121:1-6 KJV

1 I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help. 2 My help cometh from the LORD, which made heaven and earth. 3 He will not suffer thy foot to be moved: he that keepeth thee will not slumber . 4 Behold, he that keepeth Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep . 5 The LORD is thy keeper: the LORD is thy shade upon thy right hand. 6 The sun shall not smite thee by day, nor the moon by night.

In the midst of chaos and confusion, do not fear.

So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand. Isaiah 41:10 KJV



Do not fear what man can do.

Psalm 118:6-9; Luke 12:4; Matthew 10:28; Hebrews 13:6; Psalm 27:1-3; Romans 8:31; Psalm 56:4

Do not fear intimidation. 1 Peter 3:14-16

14 But even if you should suffer for the sake of righteousness, you are blessed. AND DO NOT FEAR THEIR INTIMIDATION, AND DO NOT BE TROUBLED, 15but sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts, always being ready to make a defense to everyone who asks you to give an account for the hope that is in you, yet with gentleness and reverence; 16and keep a good conscience so that in the thing in which you are slandered, those who revile your good behavior in Christ will be put to shame....

Do not fear for I am with you to prevail. Jeremiah 1:8, 19; Jeremiah 15:20; Jeremiah 20:11; Isaiah 8:10; Romans 8:31

Do not fear for I will never leave you nor forsake you.

- 1 Deuteronomy 31:6, Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the LORD your God goes with you; "He will never leave you nor forsake you."
- 2 Deuteronomy 31:8, The LORD himself goes before you and will be with you; He will never leave you nor forsake you. "Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged."
- 3 Joshua 1:5, No one will be able to stand up against you all the days of your life. "As I was with Moses, so I will be with you; I will never leave you nor forsake you."
- 4 1Kings 8:57, "May the LORD our God be with us as he was with our fathers; may He never leave us nor forsake us."
- 5 1Chronicles 28:20, David also said to Solomon his son, "Be strong and courageous, and do the work. "Do not be afraid or discouraged, for the LORD God, my God, is with you. He will not fail you or forsake you until all the work for the service of the temple of the LORD is finished."

- 6 Psalms 37:28, For the LORD loves the just and will not forsake his faithful ones. "They will be protected forever, but the offspring of the wicked will be cut off;"
- 7 Psalms 94:14 "For the LORD will not reject his people; he will never forsake his inheritance."
- **8** Isaiah 41:17 "The poor and needy search for water, but there is none; their tongues are parched with thirst. But I the LORD will answer them; I, the God of Israel, will not forsake them."
- **9** Isaiah 42:16 "I will lead the blind by ways they have not known, along unfamiliar paths I will guide them; I will turn the darkness into light before them and make the rough places smooth. These are the things I will do; I will not forsake them."
- 10 Hebrews 13:5 Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you."

Be not afraid of the terror. Psalm 91:4-6; Proverbs 3:25; Isaiah 54:14; 1 Peter 3:14

I the LORD love justice; I hate robbery in the burnt offering.

<u>Isaiah 61:8</u> For I, the LORD, love justice, I hate robbery in the burnt offering; And I will faithfully give them their recompense And make an everlasting covenant with them.

Pulpit Commentary

Verse 8. - For I the Lord love judgment. Either "the Servant" here identifies himself with Jehovah, or he cites a declaration of Jehovah which he has authority to announce. Jehovah will restore the Israelites to their land because he "loves judgment" (equivalent to "justice") and hates injustice. The Babylonian conquest, though a judgment sent by him, is, so far as the Babylonians are concerned, a wrong and a "robbery." I hate robbery for burnt offering; rather, I hate robbery with wickedness (comp. Job 5:16; Psalm 58:3; Psalm 64:7; 92:15). The transplantation of nations was a gross abuse of the rights of conquest. I will direct their work in truth; rather, I will give them their recompense faithfully. As they have been wronged, they shall be righted; they shall be faithfully and exactly compensated for what they have suffered. Nay, more - over and above this, God will give them the blessing of an "everlasting covenant" (comp. Isaiah 55:3). http://biblehub.com/isaiah/61-8.htm

Cleanse yourself of all [by the Blood, by washing, by fire, by the Word]

Psalm 51:2 Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity And cleanse me from my sin.

<u>1 John 1:9</u> If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Psalm 51:7 Purify me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; Wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.

<u>Psalm 51:10</u> Create in me a clean heart, O God, And renew a steadfast spirit within me. <u>Leviticus 16:30</u> for it is on this day that atonement shall be made for you to cleanse you; you will be clean from all your sins before the LORD.

<u>Isaiah 4:4</u> When the Lord has washed away the filth of the daughters of Zion and purged the bloodshed of Jerusalem from her midst, by the spirit of judgment and the spirit of burning, <u>Numbers 19:9</u> 'Now a man who is clean shall gather up the ashes of the heifer and deposit them outside the camp in a clean place, and the congregation of the sons of Israel shall keep it as water to remove impurity; it is purification from sin.

<u>Ezekiel 36:25</u> "Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols.

<u>Jeremiah 33:8</u> 'I will cleanse them from all their iniquity by which they have sinned against Me, and I will pardon all their iniquities by which they have sinned against Me and by which they have transgressed against Me.

<u>Ezekiel 22:15</u> "I will scatter you among the nations and I will disperse you through the lands, and I will consume your uncleanness from you.

<u>Ezekiel 20:38</u> and I will purge from you the rebels and those who transgress against Me; I will bring them out of the land where they sojourn, but they will not enter the land of Israel. Thus you will know that I am the LORD.

Ezekiel 37:23 "They will no longer defile themselves with their idols, or with their detestable things, or with any of their transgressions; but I will deliver them from all their dwelling places in which they have sinned, and will cleanse them. And they will be My people, and I will be their God.

<u>Ezekiel 36:29</u> "Moreover, I will save you from all your uncleanness; and I will call for the grain and multiply it, and I will not bring a famine on you.

<u>Ezekiel 36:33</u> 'Thus says the Lord GOD, "On the day that I cleanse you from all your iniquities, I will cause the cities to be inhabited, and the waste places will be rebuilt.

<u>Titus 2:14</u> who gave Himself for us to redeem us from every lawless deed, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds.

<u>Hebrews 1:3</u> And He is the radiance of His glory and the exact representation of His nature, and upholds all things by the word of His power When He had made purification of sins, He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high,

<u>1 Peter 1:22</u> Since you have in obedience to the truth purified your souls for a sincere love of the brethren, fervently love one another from the heart,

<u>2 Peter 1:9</u> For he who lacks these qualities is blind or short-sighted, having forgotten his purification from his former sins.

<u>Numbers 8:21</u> The Levites, too, purified themselves from sin and washed their clothes; and Aaron presented them as a wave offering before the LORD. Aaron also made atonement for them to cleanse them.

Zechariah 13:1 "In that day a fountain will be opened for the house of David and for the inhabitants of Jerusalem, for sin and for impurity.

<u>Hebrews 9:14</u> how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

<u>1 John 1:7</u> but if we walk in the Light as He Himself is in the Light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.

<u>Titus 3:5</u> He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit, <u>Hebrews 10:22</u> let us draw near with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

<u>John 15:3</u> "You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you.

<u>1 Corinthians 6:11</u> Such were some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the Spirit of our God.


<u>Ephesians 5:26</u> so that He might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word,
